Announcements (All)

UCB: Jane Rosario is departing SCP-AC. Jim Latchney, serials cataloger, is the new Berkeley representative; Systems & Discovery Services Librarian position posting (https://aprecruit.berkeley.edu/JPF02543/) [an exception to the hiring freeze was granted]

UCSC: In process of hiring an E-Resources librarian. Remote work is a possibility.

UCSB: New AUL for Research Resources & Scholarly Communication, Lidia Uziel, started in April. Also working on E-Resource Management Librarian recruitment.

UCSD: 2 positions in limbo. Waiting to see if recruitments can proceed.

UCSF: Hired E-Resources librarian on 1 year temporary appointment. 1 year hiring freeze went into effect.

UCLA: New OA Metadata Librarian beginning in June.

SCP Staffing News (Shi)

- o New Assistant Director for Systemwide Licensing, Michael Walmsley, started April 13
- o Departure of CDL license analyst, Vasu Choudhary, last day May 1
- o Hire freeze: including the shared content service coordinator position that has not been able to fill last three years

Serials Phase II Updates (Shi/Becky)

- Timeline: won't be completed in summer for Vanguard, plan to complete by November before Alma migration starts in December
- Plan for the remaining titles (near 12,000 records: will not divided by packages)
 - o Titles with 776 linking to online records (divided by DLC/PCC and the rest)
 - Titles with no 776 linking to online records (batch search OCLC# of print in online records, manually identify the rest; separate process for Chinese and non-Chinese titles)
- Manual review/switch updates (Becky)

Serials Analytics in Alma (Liz)

How do people handle serial analytics in Alma, specifically: where/how do you record treatment decisions and what do you do if your campus analyzes a CDL title locally (i.e. SCP doesn't handle the analytics)?

- UCSC: Need to investigate further
- UCSB: Haven't been doing it
- UCD: Will get documentation on practice
- UCI: Will get documentation on practice

Temporary Free Content from Vendors (Liz)

Vendors are offering a lot of free content during the corona virus shutdown. UCSD has started adding records for a good chunk of this content (I can screen share a list). Are others doing anything similar? PDF of UCSD list

- UCSD adding all records as "new," so for collections where UCSD already has some content, some
 duplicate records are allowed. This is to ensure that once the temporary access is shut off, all the
 relevant records can quickly be deleted without accidentally deleting records with full access.
- UCD: Not adding records to Primo. Using A-Z Database List to highlight collections.
- UCSC: Also using A-Z Database list.
- UCI: Added a few titles to Primo, but are being very selective.
- UCSB: Not adding records to Primo. Using a public facing page with relevant collections, and publicizing.

SILS Data Cleanup: SCP Plan (Shi)

- Review and cleanup brief SCP records in the system but not distributed
- Sending the remaining brief records (near 5000) of Chinese serials package Dacheng to OCLC data sync to add OCLC numbers by June before Vanguard load. The collection was distributed to campuses without OCLC# in 2013. About 2000 records have been replaced with OCLC records over the years.
- The only SCP records without OCLC# as a matching point will be the EEBO collection

EEBO (Early English Book Online) Updates (Shi)

- Just received another update, mostly updates to the existing records
- The previous update was in July 2018 which all participating campuses had to remove all existing records and add all records from the updates.
- SCP proposal to put it on hold, rely on reports via CDL Helpline to catch any issues
- Meanwhile explore the option using Alma CZ (Community Zone) records, the only package will not have OCLC record number to match
- Any concerns from campuses about SCP's proposal?
 - o Let Shi know by Friday, April 24

SILS Related Forecasting Topics (Shi)

- Will bring to discuss at this group and SILS Phase 4 Resource Management FG
- Loading SCP records: recommend to load SCP first
- Editing NZ records including SCP records
 - O What does this mean to SCP?
 - O Determine what SCP data needs to be protected in the shared editing environment of NZ
 - o Currently Alma campuses use 973 for SCP 793 titles

Future Agenda Items

- SCP cataloging freeze period
 - o If SCP records load first, it will be in Dec. or whenever the first load starts for Alma migration
 - O Likely means 6-7 months of no new titles added/distributed until Alma go-live July 27.
 - (i.e. once SCP records moved to Alma, SCP will likely add records to Alma but the public won't be able to see until go-live).
 - O What does it mean to campuses?
 - O How to prepare our public service librarians and users?
- Alma Network Zone
 - Editing of records
- Will campuses continue to load SCP records into campus Institution Zones to create electronic inventory?
