- 1. Announcements (All)
 - a. UCB, UCD, UCI, UCM, UCR, UCSB, UCSF no announcements
 - b. UCLA reminder that in October they announced their new continuing resources metadata Librarian Paromita Biswas.
 - c. UCSD held two on-site interviews for a Metadata Librarian for Research Data position. Mary Wickline, their academic liaison to Nursing and Allied Health, passed away after a long illness. They are currently recruiting for her position
- 2. SCP Update (Shi/Becky)
 - a. SCP closes for the holiday after Friday 12/21. Today, Dec. 17, 2018, was last weekly file. Next file will be sent on Monday, Jan. 7, 2019
 - b. OCLC is interested in knowing what we would like OCLC to do and what kinds of open access material we are working on/interested in. Becky and UCSD librarians have filled out an OCLC survey
 - i. Becky-would like people to fill out the survey if interested
 - ii. At ALAmw, MAR meeting (new MARBI) there will be discussion of how to code open access materials
 - iii. ACTION: BECKY will send the survey to this group. Due Jan 15
 - iv. ACTION: BECKY will report on the discussions about coding open access materials after ALA Midwinter
 - c. ALAmw attendance from SCPAC: Becky and Shi, Sarah W., UCLA's new librarian, Paromita Biswas
- 3. 2019- access to the MLA International Bibliography via EBSCO (Discoverable only through EDS? How is SCP handling the switch from ProQuest? Pid change only? (Shi/Becky/Kevin)
 - a. MLA signed deal with EBSCO so that the International Bibliography is only available through EDS
 - b. Kevin wants to make sure the resource itself discoverable through catalog
 - c. The change is effective of January 1, 2019
 - d. CDL put out an email a couple of months ago about MLA and an open letter they signed on about this decision

- e. Ex Libris is aware of it and working on alternative coverage
- f. PRIMO will have content until March. In Summon until early November

- h. ACTION: SHI will send a question to Holly at CDL for an update
 - i. The CDL license team is very busy with renewals right now. This is on their list, but no update
- 4. Status notification for SCP Cataloging request: Since there is no way to automate a notification for completion of request for cataloging, could we possibly forward this information to the CKGs from SCP AC? (All)

- a. It is not feasible for Becky to alert people every time a cataloging request is completed

- d. Russian resources from an SCP/UCLA collaboration are in today's SCP file. Becky worked with Peter and a student on this
 - i. UCLA student pulled up records for print of the Russian resources. Then Becky cloned online records from these records.
 - ii. ACTION: KEVIN will do short write up of the resources and Shi can include in the SCP monthly update for January.
