1. Announcements-

Congratulations to Lai-Ying Hsiung – new Chair of HOTS.

Lisa – UCB has been using Content DM for archiving Cal Docs for which UCB has done original cataloging. Will be testing CDL's Web Archiving Service (WAS). User access to WAS starts in June. There is a six month wait to access after a title is cataloged.

2. NGM update (John)—OCLC WorldCat Local update

Missing Records & Reclamation

All remaining campuses who had not previously submitted files of bib records to OCLC for the reclamation process have now done so. UCB will process NRLF's holdings with ZAP symbol after the Innovation migration is far enough along in the spring.

Testing LHR batchloading is currently underway or due to take place at 3 campuses representing the three different ILSs. Voyager and ALEPH are capable of extracting the needed data into the MARC 21 Holding Format. Innovative libraries will need to acquire a piece of software for accomplishing this.

Members of the Implementation Team, together with the leads of the Missing Records and OCLC Symbols teams, are in the process of asking OCLC a lot of questions about LHR data content and how WCL will interact with it.

OCLC Symbols

The possible set of 10 or 12 new symbols for UC Shared Print materials has been tabled, pending further discussion in Next Gen Tech Services and various stakeholders, e.g. the Shared Print Steering Task Force.

A large number of changes are being made in the April release, which will soon be posted on the SOPAG site: http://libraries.universityofcalifornia.edu/about/uc_oclc.html#updates

Many of them relate to the detailed record display.

Testing is currently underway for OCLC's ability to load large amounts of LHR data on a regular basis. Libraries using III will need to acquire software for outputting LHRS.

Jim – UC Shared Print holdings symbols – ILL implications of having multiple symbols. Will need to look at this more closely.

3. Next Gen Technical Services Update (Jim)

The SCOPE statement has been released.

The Steering Team is now trying to select people to staff the task groups. Each UL will have to approve any of the people selected for their campus. The Steering Team is also working on charges for the groups and a time-line for the work.

Any questions about the SCOPE statement? Adolfo – Roman language materials will have an SCP representative. But there is no SCP rep for non-ROMAN language materials. Jim – That's true at present: he will take the question to the Steering Team.

4. General SCP update (Adolfo and Becky) See Becky's email regarding proposed 599 UPDs sent last Friday.

Catalog maintenance cat This category includes bibliographic updates/changes made to the master record. Due to popular request title changes and ceased titles are listed out separately

SCP maintenance scp This category entails updates/changes to locally added fields (e.g., making changes to 856 \$u, \$z and 793 fields).

If there are no objections – this draft will be finalized and implemented on May 4th. This new format will appear in our May 11th SCP file.

Adolfo – another announcement—SCP reclamation – files were sent to OCLC on April 16, 2009. OCLC is currently working on these files. SCP will have additional clean-up and processing before they can post the files to grab.

SCP catalogers now have to set the ER holdings for everything they catalog, either manually or in semi-batch. Hoping for a batch method – gathering all new records into a file and setting holdings. On a weekly basis. Kate will send file of new and updated holdings to OCLC. Deletes will have to be processed manually.

Question: Do we want to do this long-term on a weekly basis or look into setting holdings on a daily basis?

Action: Check with appropriate contact person on your campus to get impression of whether weekly is acceptable. Users will not be able to check OPAC and verify whether we have items or not until the holdings are set. Get feedback from campuses at next conference call – one month away. (Adolfo will summarize the question and pros and cons in an email for us to share with our colleagues).

[Springer-Biomedical –were not in the excluded list – less than one hundred titles -- identifying the records. Problem should be resolved in a couple days. Deletes in next file.]

Ivy's response to priorities – Springer now a higher priority. Donal is checking the Springer db on a daily basis for new content, and cataloging anything new daily.

Adolfo's email about mono packages needing cataloging. We'll be seeing less than full records for these initially. They will be enhanced with subject headings and other data when there is more time. We are welcome to enhance if we have a chance – just let SCP know so they can grab the record and send out to all the campuses.

Sarah – pilot project: Davis cataloged some E-scholarship journals which will be reported to SCP for distribution to all the campuses.

CDL – web redesign: You will see some changes to the SCP web site as CDL redesigns their Inside CDL pages. SCP has already removed some content and updated other content in preparation.

Adolfo will take up the SCP monthly updates and the Launch life-cycle meetings at CDL.

Alexander Street Press – 1960s – Mono records – should come through in two weeks.
