EEBO monographic records were sent out to each campus on disc. SCP is waiting for confirmation from each campus before sending out the EEBO serial records in a SCP file. SCP will send an announcement before posting this file. Various campuses have run across issues collecting the previous EEBO records for deletion and had concerns on overlaying records.

Some RDA records were sent out recently with 3xx fields not updated. Updated records will be sent out to replace them and should overlay.

UCSD and SCP plan to transition to RDA simultaneously on January 1st.

POT5 is in the process of finalizing a survey on the setting of SCP cataloging priorities, which some members of the advisory committee should receive.
