1. Announcements-

The SCP-AC will be using a new access code (3827446) for conference calls for the remainder of Trina's term as chair.

Becky Culbertson reminded the Committee to respond to the recent SurveyMonkey survey on provider-neutral records for monographs.

2. Next Generation Melvyl update (John)-

The report was distributed via email. Some highlights:

3. SCP update (Adolfo)-

Adolfo recently distributed the SCP Annual report for 2011/2012 and shared that SCP has now cataloged over 500,000 e-resources for the UC system.

SCP will begin distributing serials cataloged in RDA to campuses very soon. There shouldn't be very many titles at first, but it is a good way for SCP catalogers to practice and for campuses to see RDA in their catalogs. Integrating resources cataloged in RDA are already being distributed.

Becky reported that catalogers are working on 3700 records from the Early American Imprints set that lack OCLC numbers.

Wanda suggested that there should be documentation regarding links for Tier 1 vs. Tier 2 resources in SCP records.
