1. Announcements

Becky Culbertson reported that Ivy Anderson paid a visit to UCSD recently. Some topics discussed were: a) current state of CRMS & orphan works for HathiTrust. Ivy reported that we need to wait to determine what the budget impact will be; b) CDL is looking into purchase on demand (PDA) models; c) Budget impacts on consortial purchasing. SCP AC discussed possibilities of how workflow might change with a PDA model. There is still much to be determined.

Becky also reported that SCP is working to create records for over 1000 ACS Symposium Series titles. There is no estimate for when these records will be sent to the UC campuses yet. SCP is waiting on the licensing agreement.

2. NGM Update (John)

- a) On November 30, a subset of ULs met to explore with OCLC what other joint collaborations UC & OCLC would want to have following the one on Next Generation Melvyl. Karen Butter, Donald Barclay, Laine Farley, Martha Hruska, and Ginny Steel were in Dublin, Ohio for a discussion. I am still hoping to get word on what got discussed or decided.
- b) Not related to Melvyl, but of relevance to SCP AC is the current discussion going on in OCLC's membership about possible changes to the 'Financial Credits Program," in which libraries contributing new and upgraded master records received "credits" that lower the monthly OCLC invoices. John was able to capture the slide set from the OCLC webinar held earlier today on this subject. He is sending that along separately.
