 - He gave a brief description of their core services and info about staffing and collections. They have shelving space for 250,000 volumes with 36,000 current volumes in the stacks, approximately 10,000 online journal subscriptions.
 - They are not going to have Reserves at this time. Indicated that they have made arrangements with some faculty to assist with scanning material on a case-by-case basis.
 - Over 70 loaner laptops
 - Talked about their security system and RFID. Was hopeful to have it up and running very soon
