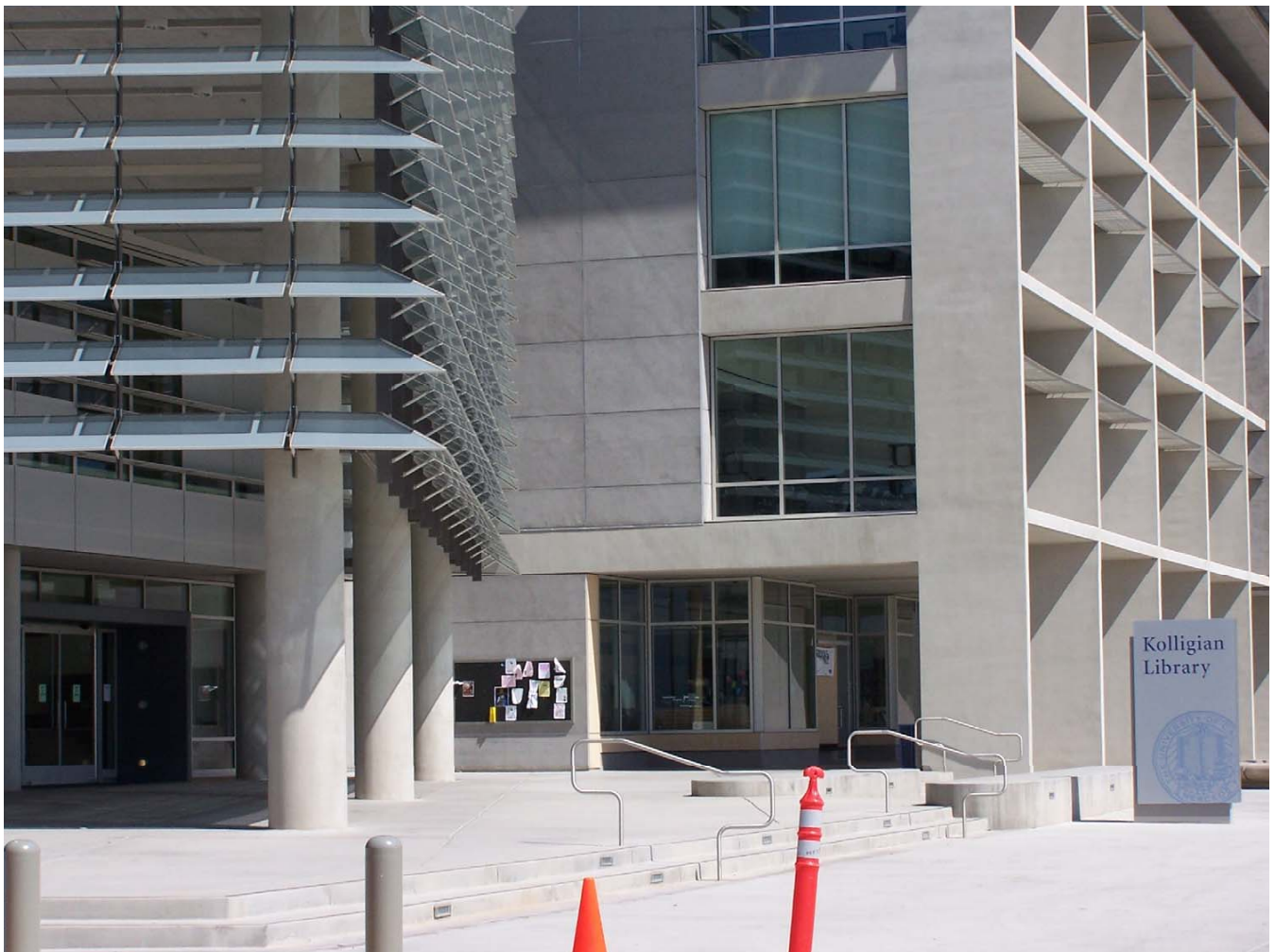


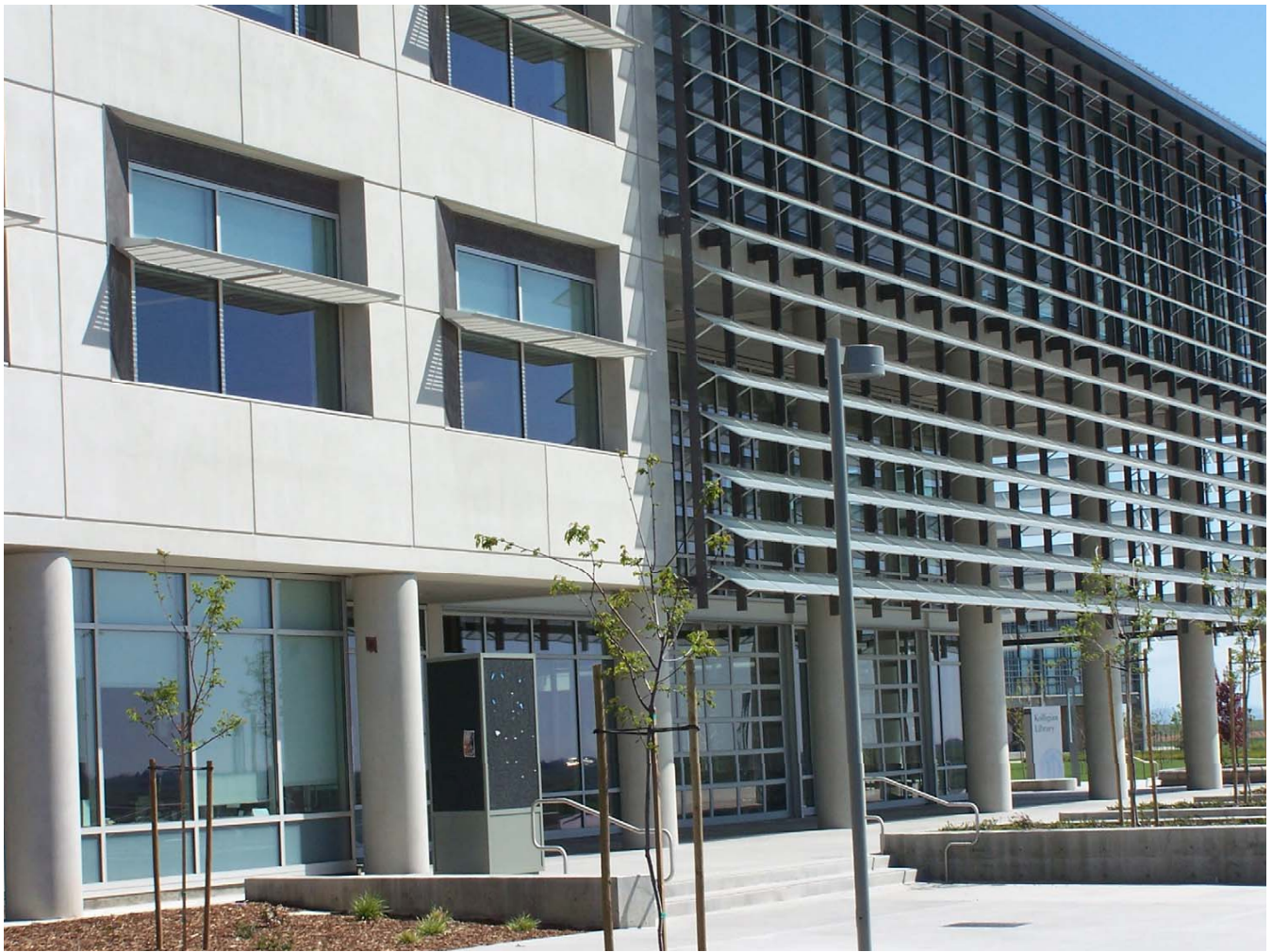

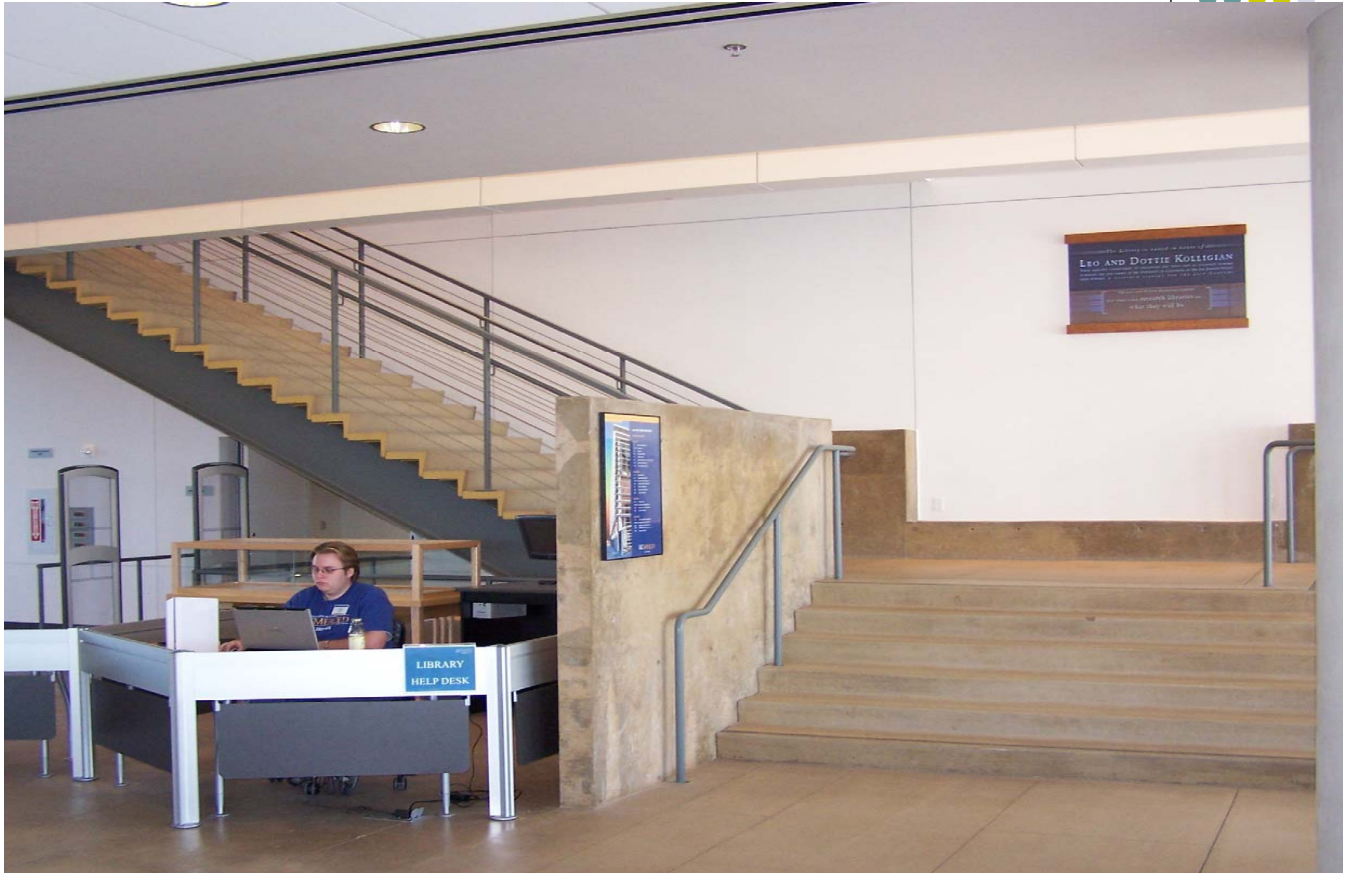


FIRST FLOOR

Main entry into 2nd Floor Circulation area.



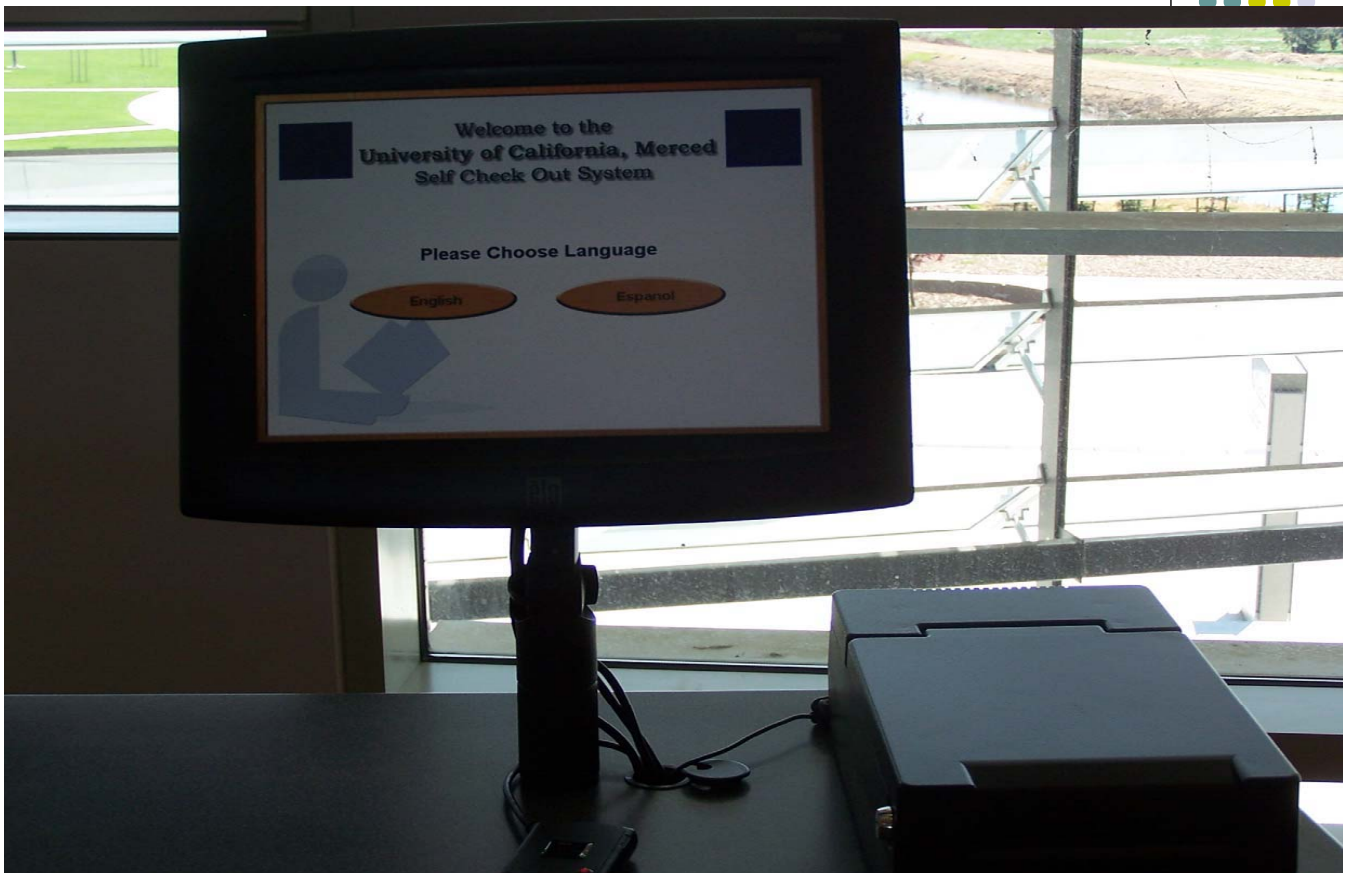




Self-check out system. 2 available on 2nd Floor Circulation area.

View from behind the Circulation Desk – notice the RFID box under the Circulation Desk on the left side.

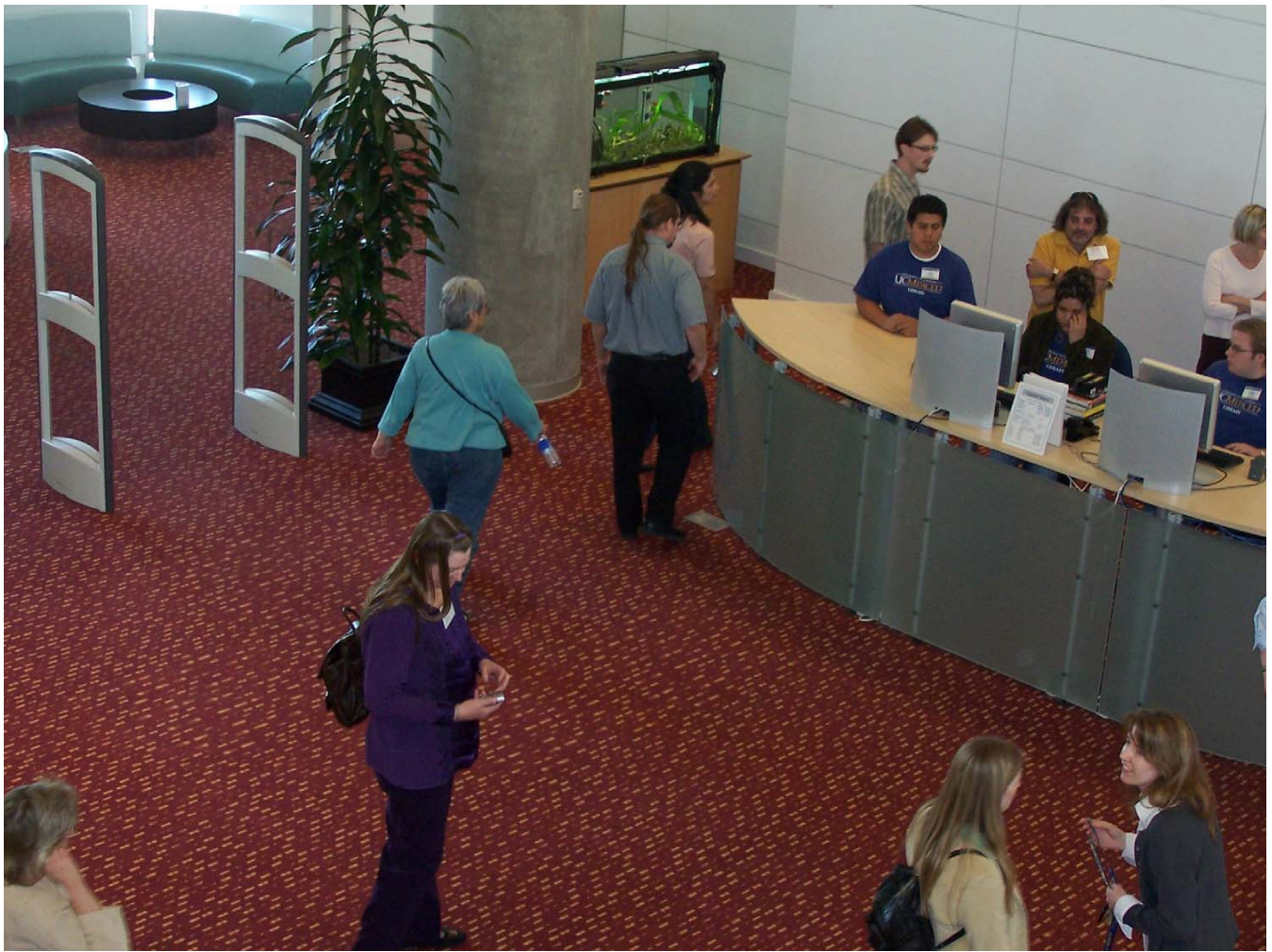


Closer view of the RFID box – located under the Circulation Desk.

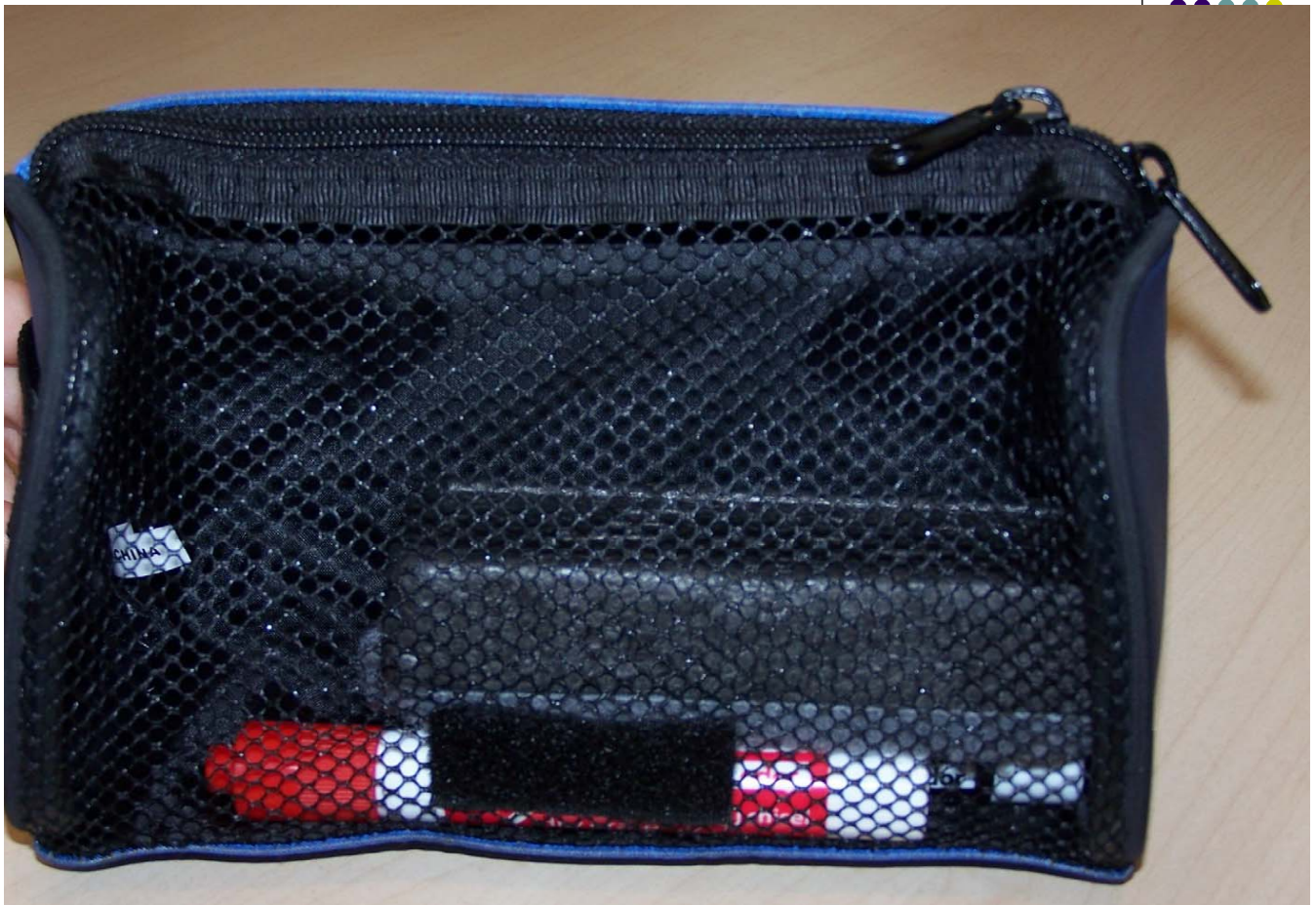

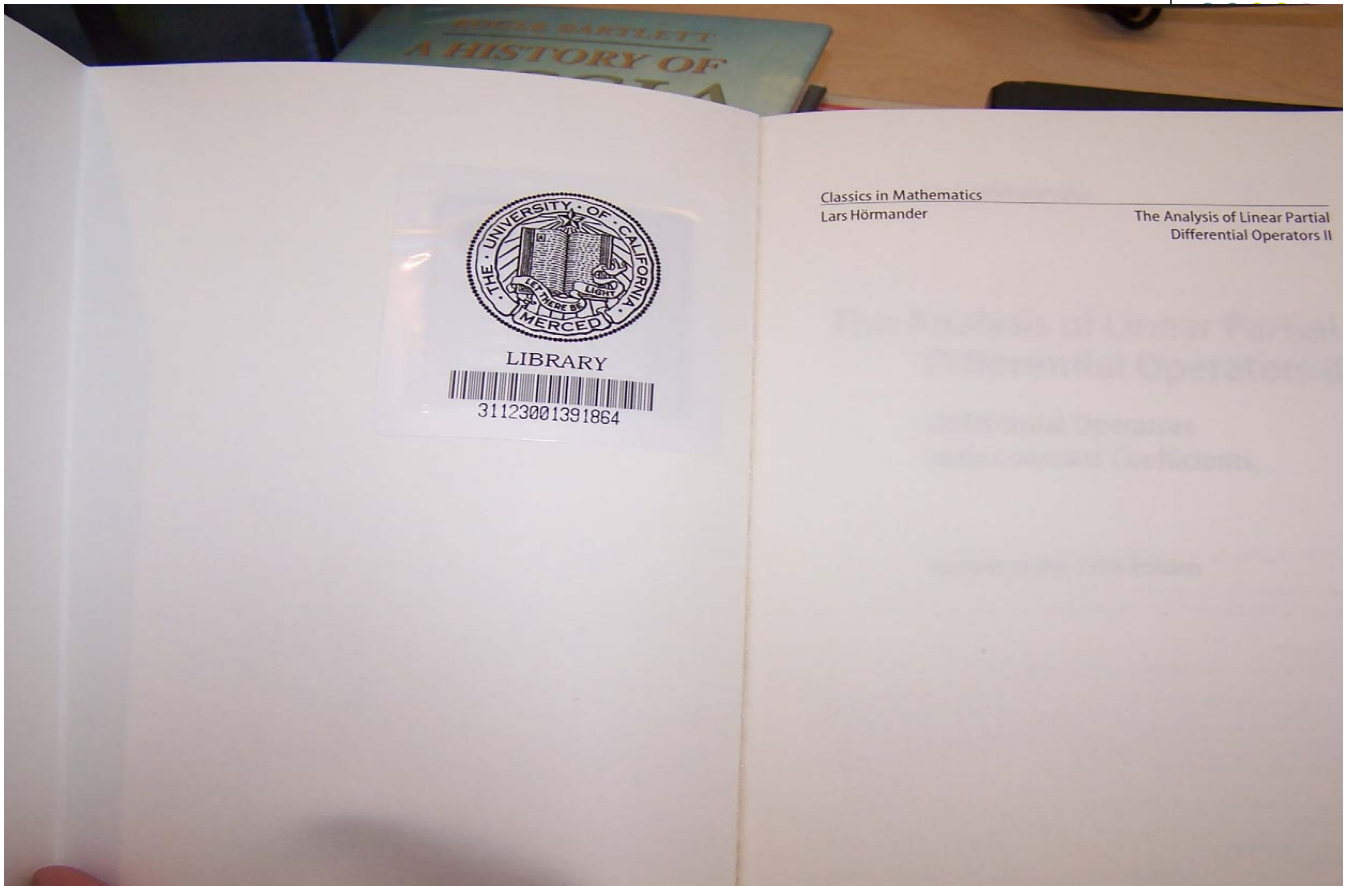




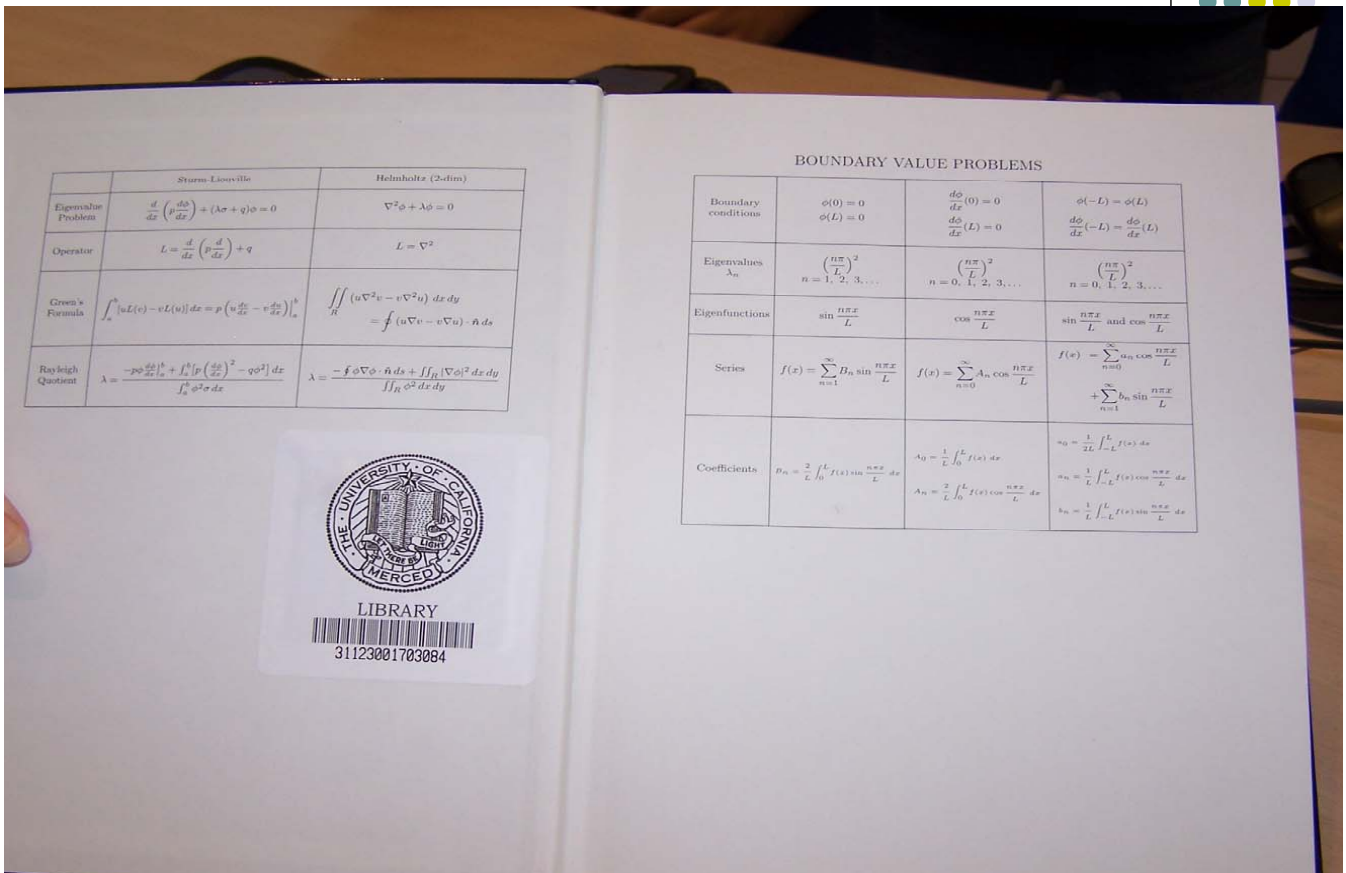

RFID TAG – INSIDE COVER

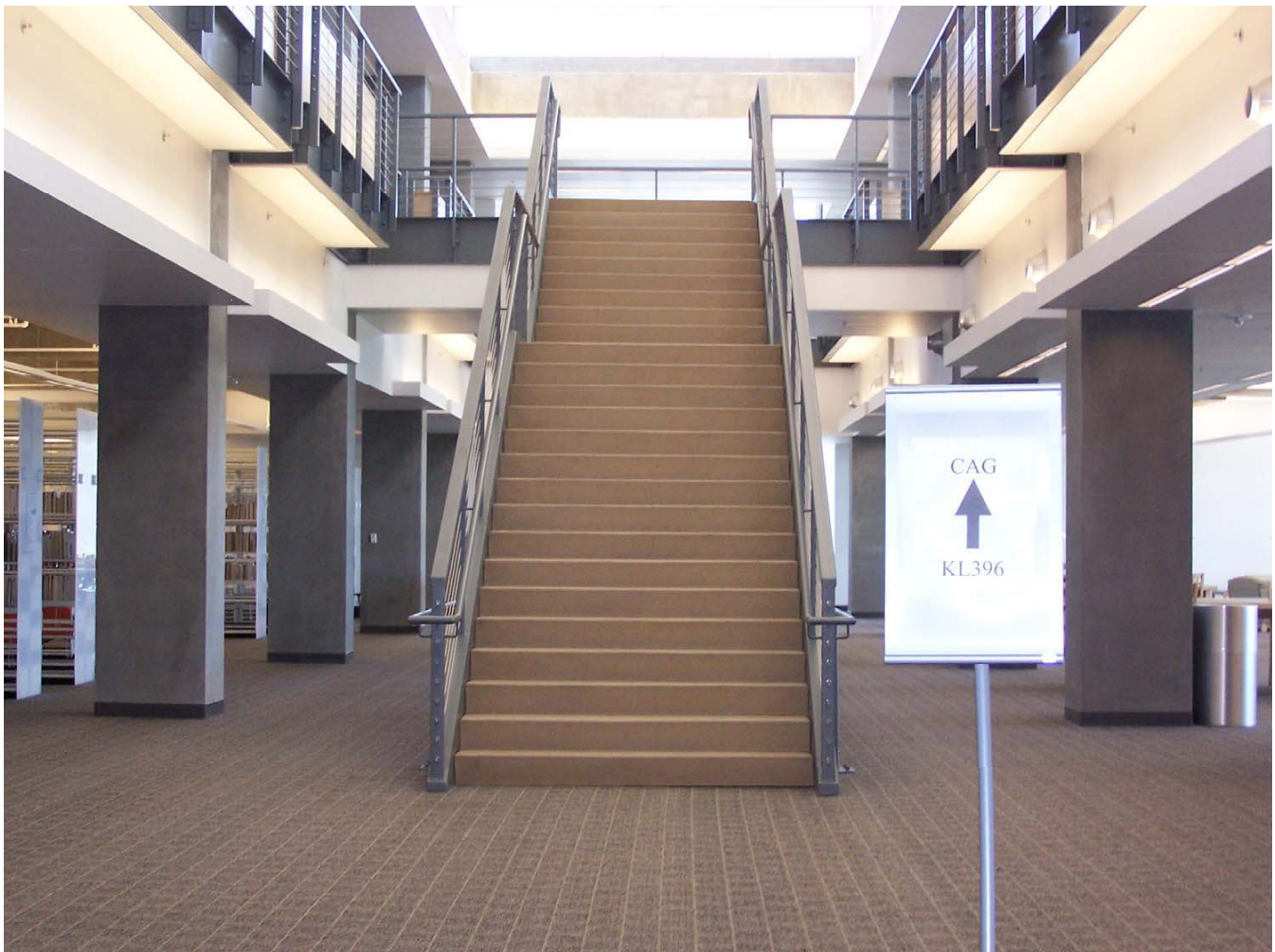

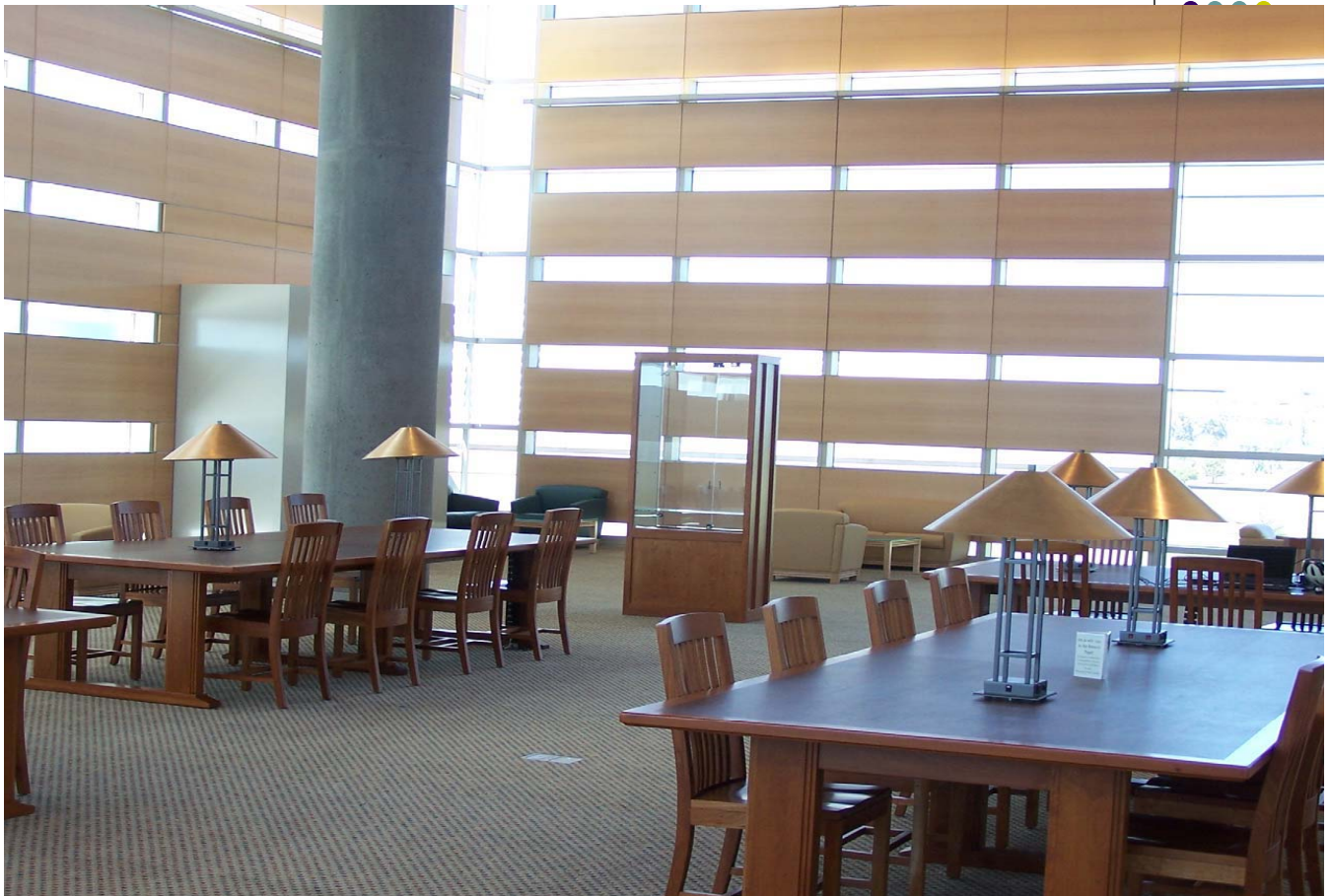

Picture frame of the 4 children to whom the McFadden-Willis Reading Room is honored for.



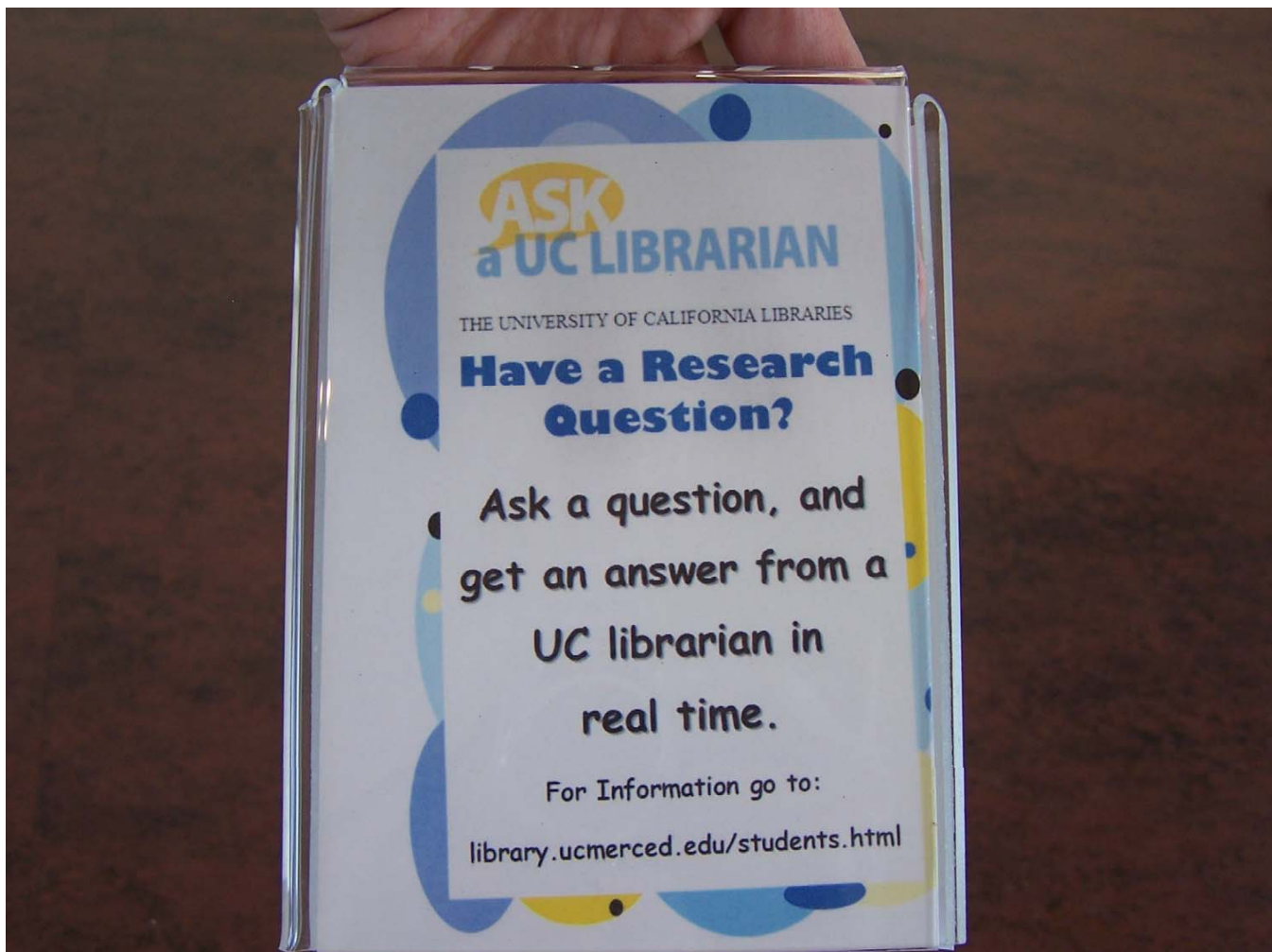
THE MCFADDEN-WILLIS READING ROOM
