1. Advance Long-Term Access to Digital Content

Play a leadership role in the development of regional, national, and international digital library programs and services — such as the HathiTrust, arXiv, and SHARE — to ensure that the cultural and scholarly record is preserved and accessible. Explore and experiment with local and systemwide initiatives to more strategically further the large scale transition to open access.

Develop a shared strategy for workforce development across the ten campus libraries and the CDL.

ASAG will investigate establishing a marketplace for identifying opportunities for shared (i.e. not systemwide) hires and positions. If a systemwide ILS is implemented in the coming years, it will likely bring about new opportunities for systemwide staff development.
