# 5. Courier Coordinator Update (5 minutes – Jimenez)

5.1. Gave Accurate the holiday schedule. In October there were fewer trouble tickets but more serious problems reported. Lost bins (red bin episode), damaged bins (one theory is that during line haul bins stacked for long periods of time), an Accurate theory is that newer bins are made of weaker plastic and more susceptible to

damage, UCSC lost 11 bins Accurate paid for replacement of half, but will no longer replace bins, bags in empty bins, zip ties on empty bins, <u>don't have a signed contract with Accurate yet so no contract (using RFP in lieu of contract) to back-up requests for accountability</u>.

5.1.1. ACTION: Jiminez will ask IAB about bins.

6. CAG Update (5 minutes – Lucas) – Independent Scholar Privileges survey; Extension Students Privileges survey Follow-up from 3/1 RSC minutes about an in person meeting. Cannot justify and in person meeting at this point. Its listserv is active and issues are responded to using it. RSC isn't sure what's happening with CAG. It's issues do not seem to follow the same pattern as IAG issues. Maybe WEST will trigger CAG involvement.

**ACTION:** Lucas as RSC liaison to CAG will bring to CAG chair the following 1) A contact list for who to contact to determine if a UC patron is eligible for privileges. 2) Suggest CAG sponsor a broader discussion and review of practices related to stolen books such as the August 2012 incidences that occurred nation-wide and in some UC libraries. 3) CAG to review is mission to determine its role as an advisory group to RSC.

ACTION: Not sure if this was an item for CAG or if RSC was going to appoint a small group to develop guidelines for proposing in person meetings.
