

# Uniform Fee Schedule for Non-UC Deposits

Effective July 1, 2008

Approved by the SLF Board via email, June 19, 2008

The SLFB Operations and Planning Committee members have reviewed the existing Fee Schedule for Non-UC Deposits. Established in 1991, the fees were based on the RLF operating expenses and workloads for 1) accessions of new deposits, 2) circulation and document delivery service, and 3) collection maintenance functions. The formulas used in 1991 to establish per-item costs were deemed to still be valid and have been applied for the revised fee schedule.

Increases of 33% (remote copying/scan) and up to 68% (accession and deaccession) are reflected in the new fees for accession, deaccession, onsite borrowing, remote borrowing, and document delivery. In large part these increases result from the changes and impacts that new online library systems have made at the RLFs, and at SRLF in particular. Legacy mainframe systems that were designed to manage the unique needs of inventory and processing functions of the storage facilities have been replaced with vendor designed turn-key systems that typically don't address the unique needs of the RLFs. The changes in these systems have significant and direct impact on productivity and staffing requirements. The proposed 2008 Fee Schedule recognizes these impacts and anticipates further expenses as the UC moves to the Next Generation Melvyl, and as UCB and NRLF position themselves to move from Gladis to a new operating system in the near future. The new Fee Schedule will become effective July 1, 2008.
