20 min	DB	Decision: DOC supports the ILL CKG's survey, though only if campuses can opt-out. Before signing off, DOC members want to consult with their UL and local stakeholders to determine participation and to review the survey questions. Because not all campuses will participate, the CKG might opt to replace some systemwide service questions with local service questions.	Action: Barclay will request that the CKG share the survey questions with DOC. Action: Barclay will investigate whether IRB review is required (to confirm the libraries don't need to go through the IRB process for the survey).
5 min	CF	Digital Reference Coordinator renewal Antoinette Avila currently serves as the UC digital reference coordinator. Her term finishes this June and she has indicated that she will not renew her contract. Avila has offered to stay on for upwards of one additional year to continue to support service assessment and to train/work with a new coordinator. DOC will discuss identifying a new coordinator at a later date.	
5 min	DB	Requirements work for the RFP is wrapping up. DOC will receive a copy of the phase 3 progress report and requirements on March 19. DOC will be able to briefly discuss the report/requirements at the March 22 meeting, and then feedback will be due on March 26. CDL submitted a Major Projects & Initiatives (MPI) funding proposal to UCOP to cover the ongoing SILS costs that fall outside of the libraries' current FTE and fund envelope; the MPI proposal is still being adjudicated.
