Announcements, Housekeeping and Calendar Review

- Minutes of the January 11, 2019 meeting were reviewed and approved.
- Reprints Desk will be a mediated service for all campuses; UC eLinks and Shared Cataloging Program (SCP) will work to ensure that holdings are identifiable and up-to-date.

Shared Print Strategies Team

- SCLG agreed to “Operational Guidelines for UC Campus Transfers of WEST Bronze Archives.”

Maps & Geospatial Data Common Knowledge Group

- SCLG received a request for a six-month moratorium on any deaccessioning of maps and other spatial resources, while the CKG develops a systemwide vision and concrete recommendations for spatial collections. After discussion, the request for a moratorium was not approved, but the CKG’s efforts to develop a vision and recommendations were welcomed.
- “Geospatial Collaborative Collection Development Agreement 2018” will receive further discussion.

Shared Cataloging Program (SCP) – Please use the [CDL Helpline](#) if you have any questions, e.g. delay, errors, etc.:

- **Cataloging Delay (if more than three months):** A title may have been missed on the vendor title list, UC-eLinks (SFX) might have not yet been activated, the title might be missing the OCLC number, to

name a few things that cause cataloging delays. It usually takes about two-three months for OCLC records to become available or for items to become available for SFX activation when new titles are added to an existing collection.

- **Cataloging Errors:** Please include the OCLC Number (preferred), ISSN, or ISBN in your inquiry.

LICENSES

- **Cambridge Books Online, 2019-2021** – Cambridge is still in the process of providing GOBI with all of the necessary title data so that the relevant titles will show up in GOBI. CDL will provide updates as they become available.
- **Elsevier Journals** – Negotiations are continuing.
- **Royal Society of Chemistry (RSC), 2019-2021** – The Portland Press license is still in progress.
- **Wiley, 2019** – CDL signed the renewal agreement on 1/22, and is waiting to receive the countersigned version back from the publisher.
- **Philpapers** – The OA resource Philpapers has been subscribed for the UC system. SCLG approved on 1/15. All UC campuses are members (UCSF at no cost).

New Launches / Transitions / Renegotiations / Cancellations

Upcoming Launches, Platform Transitions and Updates

- **Philpapers** – CDL is handling launch activities for this resource. Article forthcoming.
- **MagazinePlus, BookPlus, WhoPlus (Nichigai)** – The licensed Nichigai platform databases have changed URLs with an updated Tier 2 contract and addition of BookPlus. CDL will handle transition activities. Article forthcoming.
- **Takita Choin kyūzō kindai sakka genkōshū (JapanKnowledge)** – Takita Choin kyūzō kindai sakka genkōshū has been licensed systemwide on the JapanKnowledge platform. CDL will handle launch activities. Article forthcoming.
- **Literature Online (LION) (ProQuest)** – LION will be transitioning to a new platform in 2019. Overlap access will be available, hard switchover TBD.
- **America's Historical Newspapers (Newsbank)** – America’s Historical Newspapers will be updating their platform in January.
- **ACM Digital Library (ACM)** – ACM will be updating their platform in early 2019.
- **Naxos (Naxos)** – Naxos will be updating their platform in early 2019.
