LICENSES / OA Agreements

- **Cambridge OA Implementation for 2019** -- We are finalizing tasks to be ready for the 2019 rollout of the agreement, targeting the second full week of September to go live, although this date is subject to change. Following the 2019 go-live, we will begin to work on process development for full implementation of our intended author workflow for 2020.
- **Elsevier eBooks Front File, 2020-2022** – SCLG approved the CDL proposal with annual price caps with a 3-yr commitment.
- **Elsevier Health Science ebooks 2019** – CDL is almost ready to sign the agreement. Seven campuses are participating in the 2019 contract.
- **Elsevier Health Science ebooks 2020-2022** – CDL sent a proposal to SCLG; replies are due 8/29.
- **Elsevier Journals** -- Please see the OSC website for the status of the journal negotiation: <https://osc.universityofcalifornia.edu/open-access-at-uc/publisher-negotiations/uc-and-elsevier/>.
- **Gale Digital Scholar Lab** – The license has been signed, and CDL will move on to the launch process. Five campuses are participating.
- **Journal of Medical Internet Research (JMIR)** -- CDL is completing a draft memorandum of understanding that will govern an arrangement to support UC publication in JMIR.
- **LexisNexis API Options for TDM (REST & bulk)** – Licensing is still in progress.
- **O'Reilly Higher Education (OHE) 2020~2022** (Previously known as Safari Books Online) – CDL is in discussions with vendor.
- **Public Library of Science (PLOS)** -- CDL met with representatives from PLOS to discuss the possibility of an agreement to support UC authors publishing in PLOS journals.
- **SAGE Journals (2020)** – CDL will discuss 1-yr license agreement renewal.

Completed Launches / Transitions / Renegotiations / Cancellations

In-Process Launches, Platform Transitions and Updates

- **Early English Books (Chadwyck Healey / ProQuest)** – Early English Books will move to the main ProQuest platform in August with dual access through the end of the year. CDL will handle transition activities. Article forthcoming.
- **MIT Press eBooks 1943-2019 (MIT Press)** – 2,900 MIT Press ebook titles have been purchased for Systemwide Access on the MIT Press Platform. CDL is handling launch activities. Article forthcoming.

Upcoming Platform Transitions

- **ACM Digital Library (ACM)** – ACM will be updating their platform in Summer 2019. CDL will handle transition activities.
- **CNKI (Eastview)** – CNKI will be moving to a new server and platform this summer. CDL will handle transition activities.
- **Latin America Database (University of New Mexico)** – Gratis access to LADB will continue on the current platform for now.
