Example 1. When norms collide (NZ MMS ID 9914793089106531)

Example 2. Reproduction justification (NZ MMS ID 9914796864906531)

Both are CDL resources. Portfolios are activated in NZ but there is no information on which campus has access to the resource. As a result, both show up in UCD Primo as available. Thanks to the suppressed SCP bib/portfolios in IZ, we were able to figure out that UCD has access to the second one but not the first one. It would be very nice if all CDL collections are set up like JSTOR Arts and Sciences VII (collection ID 61403073150006531)

- This was listed as the top priority for cleanup in the update from Adriana so we did not discuss fully.
