### **Updates from SILS Phase 4 Groups**

#### **Resource Management Functional Group (Liz)**

- We're going to start testing a procedure for adding 910 notes to boundwith records this week. We need to label them so that they don't get deleted during batch jobs
- The group agreed to postpone starting WorldCat updates until the 035 cleanup at UCLA and the boundwith testing is done
- Starting to remove 856 41 fields from all records except for a subset identified by UCSB
- Some of the merge rules still need tweaking

#### **Acquisitions & E-Resource Functional Group (Sarah)**

- AEEG was cancelled last week, everyone is working on Analytics, Gobi, etc.

#### **ILS Data Cleanup Group (TJ)**

- UCLA's working on removal of incorrect OCLC numbers that are actually Voyager bib IDs (thanks, UCLA!)

## SCP SILS Phase 4 Update (Shi)

- Communication about CDL SILS related activities: will try to report on the SILS confluence page: <https://uc-sils.atlassian.net/wiki/spaces/PPC/pages/1740406800/NZ+CDL+data+cleanup+project>
- Getting collection level bib records unsuppressed and replaced is the top priority. SCP is working with CDLA to get records for confirmed collections.
  - Will try to bring 38 records into NZ after the meeting today
  - Still TBD about CZ activated collections that have many subcollections where SCP has only one bib records (Elsevier, JSTOR, CRCnetBase...)
    - This is confusing even for already-Alma campuses. Sometimes it's just easier to go with a local collection instead of having so many records
    - SCP will start with ERT and then reach out to other groups including SCP-AC, AEF, RMFG, etc.
    - May be case-by-case when one collection is more manageable than another

  - Standalone P2E portfolios cleanup have to wait until P2E for collections moved in
  - WE are start to move on to coverage data for serial records

## SCP Updates (Shi and Becky)

- Continue to work on cataloging workflow including training staff on:
  - Batch for Chinese DDA packages: CNPIEC, Airiti, added 1000+ new CNPIEC Discovery records
  - Batch on JSTOR DDA: in progress
  - Manual cataloging for OA resources
- Plan to test on replacing CZ bib records using SpringerLink Contemporary 1997-: sent to RMFG about which merge rule to use: see example in Sandbox
  - Out of box: Overlay all fields but local: OCLC#952547017
  - allUC merge rule #1: OCLC#56610315
  - allUC MDE merge rule #1: OCLC#980373253
  - SCP prefer to use the OutofBox rule (first one listed) Action: Campus get back to Shi by 6pm Monday, 9/27; silence will be considered as consent
- Still try to get hold ProQuest on adding title level records to CZ for Chinese Periodicals (20,000+ records)
- Gobi: CDL plans to bring records for Wiley, Cambridge, and Springer ebooks into the NZ. Still working with YBP since there was some confusion at first. Probably will not include holdings set in OCLC.
