SCP Updates (Shi, Becky)

- SCP proposal to stop using 930\$g: Before migration, SCP has used 930 \$g to indicate the status for a serial in a serial package: code a=active, i=inactive, m=moving wall. It was used for statistics purposes for some campuses. After migration, serial coverages are recorded in portfolios; most CDL serials are CZ managed bib records with CZ portfolios and don't have SCP 930 field. Does any campus still use SCP 930\$g to pull statistics? any reasons that we shouldn't stop using 930\$g?
 - Received support from: UCD, UCI, UCLA, UCM, UCR, UCSB, UCSC, UCSF
 - Haven't heard back from: UCB and UCSD
 - Consider majority support for this change to be official
- Added several Japanese new resources with cataloging support from Naomi Shiraishi of UCB
 - JapanKnowledge two add-on collections: Shiryo Sanshu, Heian ibun

- [Gale's World Scholar Transition](#): The collection name has changed to: **Archives of Latin American and Caribbean History, Sixteenth to Twentieth Century**. Cataloging for collection level and title level have completed for launching this transition. (Becky can add details)
- JSTOR subscription upgrade: Starting with the Jan 1, 2024 subscription period, CDL managed multiple Jstor packages have been upgraded to **JSTOR Archival Journals and Primary Sources Collection** (aka Full Access collection). This comes with 27 collections including JSTOR Art & Science Collection I-XV and other subject collections. SCP staff helped with title reconciliation and cataloging for this transition.
- CRL Global Press Archive: Cataloging in progress for Phase II and catch up for Phase I., both OA and CDL IP restricted
- IZ/NZ related issues in primo/alma: please report to CDL Helpline, CDL is keeping track on incidences reported and hope to help us understand the system better and help troubleshooting
- Four of SCP staff attended Wikidata Institute during Jan-Feb.
