  - Display OA indicator based on setting in portfolio (created by UCLA)
     Everyone, please encourage people to vote.
     This should be applied to the "Gold" titles (i.e., complete open content)
     Portfolio level setting would allow manual edit (e.g., when something is incorrectly labeled as OA, etc.)
  - Allow customization of link prioritization in the merged record to prioritize OA

## **SCP Updates** (Shi, Becky)

- JSTOR DDA Transition:
  - o JSTOR stopped hosting a DDA program. DDA management is done by GOBI now.
  - Transition started on July 29 and completed on July 31. CDL ERT has been reviewing and reconciling the transition report with existing records in the JSTOR DDA collection in NZ.
  - Transition reconciliation is almost done; started to review new files and update/adjust routine workflow as needed
  - Pre-transition purchased titles are also added to GOBI as already owned status
  - FAQ is being developed which includes how titles in different statuses (pre-purchsed, purchased, and pre-transition purchased) will appear in GobiTween service website using CDL account and campus account (screenshots included)
    - Shi will provide a link to the FAQ slides when it becomes available.
- Taylor & Francis Journals:
- As communicated by the Transformative Agreement Working Group, in preparation for the new agreement, Taylor & Francis has changed content access for UC on August 15, 2024. As of that date, current-year content (2024) has been reduced to journals included in the read access title list. CDL ERT has updated portfolios in the Network Zone by closing the date to 2023 for titles we lost access to current-year content (2024)(approx. 900 titles).

Further information will become available once the agreement is signed.

  - 720 is for uncontrolled name; name was originally in direct order in ProQuest records; should it be kept in direct order or is 720 even necessary?-- to be discussed at RM-OST
