Announcements (All)

UCSD (Renee)

- 5 UCSD monos catalogers (from CJK, Special collections, and Books & Serials) started basic serials cataloging training last week. They will participate in advanced serials cataloging training in July.
- UCSD will be participating in the CONSER DOAJ cataloging project for 2025-2026. Is there other UC interest in making this a UC CONSER Funnel cataloging project?
 - o Possible interest from UCSB, UCI but at a future date
- UCSD will be implementing OpenAthens at the end of May. In preparation for this
 transition, we updated all our restriction notes from "Restricted to UCSD IP addresses"
 to "Restricted to UC San Diego". Since PIDs do not resolve properly through OpenAthens,
 we also converted the URLs in 39K portfolios (from PIDs to native URLs) and a few
 hundred more in collections.

- UCSD has made the decision to stop minting new CONSER PURLs (BibPURLs) for OA
 resources. We maintain our commitment to BibPURL maintenance and continue to use
 them in our local portfolios.
 - Other libraries have stopped minting too or mint only a few

UCLA

- UC CONSER Funnel updates:
 - Began working with Berkeley on reviewing records for new cataloger. Becky brought up the potential for the DOAJ project, but they would likely defer until next year
