**Announcements (All)**

- UCLA:
  - Still unsure about size of potential budget cut for the Library.
  - Will be starting a restructuring starting in the Fall. Exact details are TBD
  - Our Collections Analysis & Services Specialist, Caitlin Wells, will be leaving at the end of the week. We'll be attempting to replace her.
- UCD
  - The Library has been assigned an 8% cut over two years (i.e., 4% a year).
  - Several positions not being backfilled including a serials cataloger position.
  - We are moving forward with a [Metadata Librarian](#) recruitment (in progress)

**Updates from SILS Groups**

**Resource Management (Catherine)**

ETD MARC record conversion approved; loading of MARC records from eScholarship will begin soon; full workflow (including embargo management determined to be out of scope for RM)

95X-99X fields restricted; cannot be added to NZ records; can be deleted (same as 590 fields)

Working through workplan and prioritization for 2025-2026

Message sent out announcing ETD workflow change by eScholarship.

**E-Resources (Sarah)**

### SCP Updates (Marcus, Becky)

- For SCP monthly stats, updated Analytics reports to include e-resources loaded through Worldshare Collection Manager (example: US gov docs, Cal Docs)
- Materials Research Society was dropped but now back again.

### Other

- Use of SCP-L (Kevin)
  - Any information on status of SCP-L?
  - Any qualms with retiring it, and just using SCPAC-L?
- Action:** SCP-L Will be removed from documentation (delisted).
- Continuing discussion on UC ...er OCLC symbols and maintaining holdings for e-resources (from July meeting)
  - Any updates from campuses?
    - UCSD: asked ILL folks, they do not use er OCLC symbols for resource sharing
    - UCSF: checked with Collections colleagues, we do not use -er OCLC symbols
    - UCSC: ILL doesn't use er OCLC symbols, do not set local er holdings
    - Key points (Marcus):
      - Vast majority (74%) of shared electronic resources are managed through CZ. CZ bibliographic records either lack OCLC numbers, have multiple OCLC numbers or have incorrect OCLC numbers (for example, the print OCLC number).
      - Only 26% of NZ e-resources are from WorldCat (with OCLC numbers)
      - With budget cuts and subscription cancellations, maintaining ERM holdings in OCLC is increasing SCP workload (in addition to updating group settings, notes in NZ shared collections).
      - Currently [NZ WorldCat updates do not include the ...er oclc symbols](#)
        - CUV, CUY, CLU, CUS, CUI, ZAP, ZAS, UCILW, LLB, CBG, CLETH, UCFTA, CUN, MERUC, MERA, CUT, RQE, CRU, CUZ
    - Catherine: Would like to have RM discuss with regards to getting updated records in the Network Zone. In particular, authority control is managed via WorldCat Daily Updates and not via the Alma preferred term correction. Although we had not yet implemented WCD for electronic resources, that was intended to be looked at once SCP had finalized their cleanup following migration.
