### **Announcements (All)**

### **Updates from SILS Groups**

#### **Resource Management (Catherine)**

WIPT (Workstream Improvement Project) update: a new feature to restrict editing NZ rules has been activated in three PSBs (NZ, Berkeley, and UCLA) on Jan. 19; testing period will go through Feb. 20.

Another WIPT update (from Kevin): EXL is updating documentation regarding the issue of NZ data appearing in IZ analytics

#### **E-Resources (Sarah)**

Discussion on CRL NZ activation issues. CDI links leading to 403 forbidden errors. Unclear if CRL has actually sent new metadata to ExL yet. Sherry L. will provide updates as they are available.

### **SCP Updates (Marcus, Becky)**

CDL continues work on [subscription cancellations](#), SCP is cleaning up NZ bib records of cancelled resources.

## [Alma February release notes](#) "User ID Appended to System for Manual Jobs"

When running manual jobs, the user ID can now be appended to "System" in Alma entities updated by the job. For example, when the user John\_Branson runs a manual job, instead of "System" appearing in the Physical Item Editor Modified-By field, Alma now displays "John\_Branson (System)".

This feature has to be manually turned on.

### **Other**

- UCLA is looking into publishing holdings for monographs from Alma to Gobi. Have any other campuses or CDL done this? Any specs to share? (Kevin)
  - UCSD has done this for print single-volume monos. Doing it for ebooks or multivols proved to be too difficult.
  - UCI is in the process of setting this up, but we also may not be able to do it for ebooks or multivols.  
Sending/including the full ISBNs of each vol on a multivol set could be a problem.
